(Check all that apply) **■ MVMF CARES SCHOLARSHIP** - \$5,000 Awarded to a first year student in good scholastic standing that has demonstrated current and past volunteerism and community involvement. ☐ MVM FOUNDATION PUBLIC HEALTH SCHOLARSHIP - \$5,000 With increasing need to attract and train veterinarians in the field of public health and epidemiology, the MVM Foundation awards a \$5,000 scholarship for a student with an interest in veterinary public health. This annual scholarship is to provide a stipend for additional training or to offset additional tuition costs incurred while participating in the joint DVM/MPH program. Scholarship funds could also be used to reimburse travel and lodging expenses for a DVM student who will participate in a public health-related externship such as at the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. The following criteria should be met for this scholarship: 1) A College of Veterinary Medicine student who has demonstrated an interest and commitment to veterinary public health either through research, service or externship training. 2) Ideally, the student will be concurrently enrolled in the DVM/MPH program. 3) Eligible students may be 1st, 2nd, or 3rd or 4th year students. 4) The student has achieved high academic standing. 5) The student has financial need. **■ MVM FOUNDATION MARGARET POMEROY SCHOLARSHIP** - \$5,000 Awarded to a 2nd year veterinary medical student with both financial need and good scholastic standing. Preference given to a Minnesota high school graduate. □ ARROWHEAD VETERINARY MEDICAL ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP - \$3,000 Awarded to a 2nd, 3rd or 4th year student based on financial need and in good scholastic standing, with preference given to a student from the outstate Arrowhead region of Minnesota or Wisconsin. ■ MVM FOUNDATION SPANNAUS SCHOLARSHIP - \$5,000 Awarded to a 3rd year veterinary medicine student with financial need and good scholastic standing, with preference given to a Minnesota high school graduate. The scholarship should be used for tuition, books, and fees. ■ MVM FOUNDATION COMPANION ANIMAL SCHOLARSHIP - \$5,000 Awarded to a 4th year veterinary student with a companion animal objective, good scholastic standing, & financial need. ☐ MVM FOUNDATION FOOD ANIMAL SCHOLARSHIP - \$5,000 Awarded to a 4th year veterinary student with a food animal objective, good scholastic standing, & financial need with the intention of practicing in Minnesota. ☐ MVMA AWARD – LEADERSHIP AWARD - \$5,000 Awarded to a 4th year veterinary student based on leadership – given by the MVMA. **■ MVM FOUNDATION DR. TOM BLOOM MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** - \$1,500 Awarded to a 4th year, Minnesota resident preferred who is recognized for his/her community service contribution (whether in the veterinary school, or in the outside community) and has demonstrated a willingness to help others succeed. ☐ MVM FOUNDATION VHA MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP - \$1,500

Awarded to a 4th year veterinary student with a companion animal objective and good scholastic standing. The applicant must also submit a short essay (maximum 200 words) with the application package that answers the question: "How does Veterinary Hospitals Association (VHA) benefit its members?" This is an annual scholarship in memory of deceased VHA members.

☐ ACADEMY POMEROY DVM/PHD SCHOLARSHIP - \$2,500

Awarded to a student in the combined U of M DVM/PhD program, preferable when the PhD is started and the DVM is completed.

☐ MVM FOUNDATION JAMES O. HANSON CONTINUING EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP - \$5,000

Awarded to a post-graduate student

- 1) A veterinarian who has left practice to return to the College of Veterinary Medicine or comparable residency program as an intern or resident to continue their education and expand their knowledge.
- 2) If not #1, the award will be presented to a CVM intern who is staying at the U of M to continue their education through a residency program at the CVM.
- 3) If not #2, the award will be divided between two residents.

In all cases, the award should be presented, if possible, to a person who meets the following criteria: a) Minnesota practitioner; b) University of Minnesota CVM graduate; and c) MVMA member or student MVMA member.
